About the Award

The Awards assist emerging weavers each year to set up in business by providing studio space and business support provided by [Cockpit Arts](#) as well as shared use of looms.

The Award contributes to the cost of a place at Cockpit Arts, as well as business support.

The Awards are only open to weavers who have graduated within the last 5 years.

Two year Award

This is a two year Award, subject to a review for a second year.

In the first year a £3,000 fee is given by the Clothworkers' Company with an additional £1,000 paid by the Awardee.

In the second year the Clothworkers' Company gives £2,000 and the Awardee pays £2,000.

Benefits

The Award includes the following benefits:

- Studio space and use of looms within the Cockpit Arts business incubator, [Deptford, London SE8](#)
- Business incubation / acceleration services including on-site coaching and workshops
- Selling and promotional opportunities including Cockpit Arts twice-yearly Open Studios public selling weekends and other events
- Opportunity to collaborate with other makers in the Cockpit community
- Access to office facilities and resource centre

Key dates

Applications open in March and shortlisted applicants will be invited to interviews in April, with successful applicants expected to take up their place in the weave studio from July.
